## Allegany Nature Pilgrimage Checklist - Birds

This checklist was revised as of September 1, 1999 based on the records of the previous 20 years of ANP participants, the 1992 checklist by Gardner & Sundell, and the Allegany State Park checklist published in 1995 by the Park. This checklist is intended for use by ANP participants and thus reflects the birds likely to be observed in the Park during late May and early June. This version features abundance codes (described on the back) that provide the user with an indication of the likelihood of observing each species. The birds are classified in accordance with AOU 7th edition. This checklist includes 153 species and was prepared by Frank Gardner and Dick Miga.
